- 2. The hull and keel measurements marked * (Items 1–30) shall be taken by the Measurers appointed by the appropriate National Authority and entered on this form before the hull and keel leave the Licensed Builder's premises.
- 3. The remaining measurements on hull, keel and spars (Items 31–68) may be taken by any appointed Measurer and need not be taken in conjunction with Items 1–30 on the premises of a Licensed Builder.
- 4. The Licensed Builder who moulds and assembles the hull and the Licensed Builder who supplies the keel, or fits out the hull, shall sign the appropriate Declarations at the end of this form.
- 5. Each Measurer shall sign the appropriate Declaration at the end of this form, adding any comments which may affect the granting of a certificate.
- 6. The form, when completed, shall be forwarded to the National Authority (or the International Tempest Association if there is no National Authority) together with the keel bulb weight declaration and the International Class Fee receipt. The latter is obtainable from the International Tempest Association.
